

### Related Products – Mobile Digital Recorders (MDR-600, MDR-500 and MDR-400 Series)

Although the current range of Brigade Mobile Digital Recorder is the MDR-600 Series, there are some older models still in circulation. This document explains how to identify the different types and which software is required to view the video footage.

The **MDR-600 Series** are identified with either **MDR-644 Series** or **MDR-641 Series** on the front, under the Brigade logo. The MDR-644 looks similar to the MDR 500 Series, but has 4 analogue and 4 IP camera ports on the back. These product uses the current version of the **MDR-Dashboard 6.0** *The MDR-641 also requires the MCU Reader to connect it to the users PC.*

The **MDR-500 Series** can be identified as being grey with a chrome handle. There is a 4 channel (camera) model and the 8 channel model has an SD / SIM card door on the front right. This product uses the current version of the **MDR-Dashboard 6.0** *The MDR-504 is now obsolete.*

MDR-408

The **MDR-400 Series** is very similar to the MDR-500, but is black with a chrome handle. This product also uses the current version of the **MDR-Dashboard 6.0** which needs to be **Run as Administrator** to view the footage. *These products are now obsolete.*
